

Framsden Fundraisers

A bit of background



- Prior to the current group setting up FF there was a small group – ‘Friends Fundraising for Framsdén’ who organised events to raise funds for the church and wider village.
- Framsdén Fundraisers was set up in 2010, following Open Meetings, and set about becoming a registered charity. The Aims as set out in the Constitution, are:
 - ◇ To promote community involvement in functions, events and other activities, encouraging residents to live in a sustainable manner and to have regard to the local environment and ecology
 - ◇ To raise money in furtherance of Village facilities and the quality of life of its residents, supporting the Parish Council, The Parochial Church Council, The School and other Community Groups in the execution of their duties, obligations and objectives. Additionally, to work in support of other wider Charitable causes as may be considered deserving and appropriate from time to time.
 - ◇ To promote such purposes as are exclusively charitable according to the Laws of England and Wales for the benefit of the inhabitants of the Village of Framsdén and the surrounding area, “as the Trustees may from time to time determine”.
- Over the last 6 years FF has been instrumental in establishing and running a number of events including quizzes, safari suppers, barn dances, concerts, Christmas events and much more.
- As well as helping develop a community spirit and raising funds for local projects FF has also raised monies for wider charities including Combat Stress, MacMillan, St Elizabeth Hospice and many others.
- Other significant projects undertaken include the setting up of the Table Tennis Club, the Woodland Group, restoration of the War Memorial, hosting part of one leg of the Tour of Britain Cycle Race and supporting the refurbishment and repainting of the village hall.



- A ‘200 Club’ ran successfully for a number of years and not only did this contribute significantly in financial terms but it also provided the village with a comprehensive database making communication and information sharing very simple. Currently, consideration is being given to the reinstatement of the 200 Club if there is enough support.
- At the beginning of 2016 a number of new Trustees have been elected and it is hoped that this will bring fresh ideas and enthusiasm to ensure that FF continues to work in the best interests of our beautiful village and its residents.
